Why Report a Phishing Email?

Reporting a suspected phishing



'Report a Phish' tool, you're showing your organization that you know what phishing is, that you know how to properly report it, and you care about protecting your organization



informed, alert, and understand what to do next. If it is a phishing simulation, you will earn a Beauceron score reward for reporting it.



It's important to recognize the difference between unwanted or unsolicited email (spam), and a phishing attempt. When you report spam,

it may not be clear to your organization that you know what a phishing attack is.





three small dots or an ellipsis icon.


Click it.
