

BirthPlace Visitation:

CENTERED ON EXCELLENCE

- Visiting guidelines are not the same in BirthPlace as in the rest of the hospital.
- A Healthy patient's visitors are limited to the same 2 individuals throughout the patient's entire stay. BP bands will be provided for the 2 visitors designated by the patient.
- A patient that is symptomatic, under investigation or Covid positive is allowed one visitor for the entire stay (who must remain in the room at all times).
- The support person of a patient under investigation or COVID+ is considered under investigation and can stay if they are asymptomatic.
- Once a visitor leaves the hospital they are not allowed to return. Visitors (of healthy patients) can go out to their car (when necessary) as long as they wear a mask and don't have contact with anyone.
- No visitors under 12 (siblings included).

BirthPlace Masking:

- Masks are required to be worn anytime a patient or support person is outside their assigned room.
- Patients will be asked to don their mask anytime a health care worker is in the room with them.
- Patients and support person(s) may utilize the same mask during their hospital stay as long as the mask is not visibly soiled or wet.
