## BASED ON GRACE UNBOUNDED: DEVOTIONS FOR LENT 2022

These prompts are meant to keep children engaged in your family's Lent devotional practices. Most of the prompts cover multiple days, so it's okay if you skip a day. Some days don't have a prompt at all because the reading is less concrete. We hope these prompts will help your children connect with faith this spring!

**March 2-3:** Draw a picture of someone being baptized.

**March 5-7:** Draw a picture of someone reading the Bible.

**March 8-13:** Draw a picture of someone who's hurt or sick getting help to feel better.

**March 16-18:** Draw a picture of a neighbor.

**March 19-20:** Draw a picture of someone praying.

**March 22-23:** Draw a picture of a meal you ate with a large group of people.

**March 24-25:** Draw a picture of something you lost and found again.

**March 26-30:** Draw a picture of you with the grownup or grownups who take care of you.

**April 1:** Draw a picture of a kid who is younger than you.

**April 3-4:** Draw a picture of someone climbing a tree.

**April 6:** Draw a picture of communion.

**April 7-11:** Draw a picture of someone being treated unfairly.

**April 12-14:** Draw a picture of someone forgiving someone else.

**April 15:** Draw a picture of people feeling sad.

**April 16:** Draw a picture of people getting good news.
