High school students and college freshmen who meet ACT and GPA requirements are eligible for early admission acceptance. Nursing coursework begins each fall and requires two years to complete.

Transfer, 2-year track: Early Admission

90% Tuition Assistance | 94% NCLEX Pass RateOnly at RCoN, BSN students are eligible for up to 90% tuition assistance through the HCA Scholarship/Loan Forgiveness program, in exchange for a two-year work commitment as a registered nurse within the HCA MidAmerica division. NCLEX as of 1/2021.

Early Admission Eligibility

- 1. Requirements
 - High school seniors need a minimum 3.0 high school GPA with 22 ACT or 3.2 high school GPA with 21 ACT.
 - College freshmen need 3.0 or 2.8-2.99 cumulative GPA with at least 24 credit hours.
- 2. To enroll, students are required to have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA or a 2.8-2.99 cumulative GPA with a B- or better in Anatomy and Physiology.
- 3. All coursework must be a grade of C or better in required transfer courses.

Application Deadlines

- Apply September of senior year of high school through spring of freshman year of college.
- Acceptance made on a rolling admission basis.
