STALLION BREEDING REPORT GUIDE

Getting Started – Before filing

- Stallion and mare(s) must be AQHA registered or an [AQHA established Thoroughbred](#).
- Stallion has completed DNA type and Genetic Trait Panel on file.
 - **Tip:** For easier processing, complete the genetic testing before filing the breeding report. Genetic testing is required prior to registering any offspring.
- Due Date:**
 - North of the equator - November 30 of breeding year.
 - Per Rule REG110.1 – Stallion breeding reports are not considered received until they have arrived at the office and are date stamped by AQHA. Paperwork must be received on or prior to November 30 of the breeding year at 11:59 p.m. Central.
 - South of the equator – June 30 of breeding year.

How To – Filing a Stallion Breeding Report

- 1.** Provide the official AQHA registration name and number of the stallion.
- 2.** Provide the official AQHA registration name and number of each mare.
- 3.** List exposure dates for each mare.
 - a.** Exposure dates **MUST** be listed within the same calendar year.
 - b.** If you are unsure of the exact exposure dates, January 1 - December 31 of the breeding year can be listed.

- 4.** If the breeding method is frozen or transported semen, this must be indicated in the designated area.
- 5.** If the breeding location is different from the owner/business address, provide that information in the designated area.
- 6.** The owner of the stallion at the time of breeding/lessee/authorized agent must sign the Stallion Breeding Report.
- 7.** Stallion Breeding Reports are due in the office on November 30 of each breeding year.
 - a.** If the breeding is south of the equator, this must be indicated in the designated area.
- 8.** In order for multiple foals to be registered out of the same mare during the same breeding year, the mare must be listed each time she is exposed/has embryos pulled within the breeding year.
- 9.** Payment information is required before processing.
- 10.** The stallion owner must have an active membership.

Note: Failure to submit and pay for a breeding report could lead to the recorded owner of the stallion at the time of breeding being placed on suspension. All mares exposed to the stallion during the breeding year need to be listed on the report.
