CALGARY & BANFF - 4 Days | Rocky Mountains Student Tour

DAY 1

10:15 a.m. Arrive in Calgary, where your Tour Leader will meet you at the airport.

11:00 a.m. Board your motor coach and depart for Banff.

1:00 p.m. Lunch

2:30 p.m. Guided Tour of Cave and Basin National Historic Site.

Experience the birthplace of Canada's national parks and learn about the natural and cultural history of the mountains. Discover the hot water that seeps from the rocks, smell the minerals, and walk along the Upper Basin Trail

4:30 p.m. Banff Gondola to Sulphur Mountain. Experience incredible views of the Canadian Rockies as you soar 2281 metres above sea level to the top of Sulphur Mountain. Once there, walk the boardwalk to Samson's Peak and find the historic Cosmic Ray Station.

6:30 p.m. **Dinner**

8:00 p.m. Banff Upper Hot Springs. Soak in the historic spa and restored 1930s heritage bathhouse against a backdrop of spectacular alpine scenery. You will luxuriate in the comfort of soothing hot water where travellers have come to "take the waters" for more than a century.

5:00 p.m. Free time to explore Banff. Walking down the main street of this spirited town, you are struck by the view of the mountains in front of you. Shop along Banff and Bear Streets, and don't be surprised to see wildlife grazing nearby.

10:00 a.m. Educational Program at the Royal Tyrrell Museum.

Programs include curriculum-based content in science, social studies, mathematics, and art for students in kindergarten through grade 12.

11:00 a.m. Visit the Royal Tyrrell Museum of Palaeontology. At Canada's only museum dedicated exclusively to the study of ancient life, you will view engaging exhibits that bring the prehistoric past to life.

3:00 p.m. Orientation Tour of Calgary. Your Tour Leader will guide you around the city at the centre of Canada's oil industry. Calgary is still steeped in the western culture that earned it the nickname Cowtown.
