

CHINA - 12 Days | Student Educational Tour

Day 1: Board your flight to Beijing

Day 2: Beijing

- Meet your Tour Leader at the airport and transfer in to the city centre.
- Join your Tour Leader for an orientation walk around the area to get to know the city.

Day 3: Beijing

- Start the day with a visit to Tiananmen Square, which has been the stage for many mass movements of 20th Century China and has been a place of pilgrimage for Chinese people.
- Explore the Forbidden City, a 250 acre complex which was the Chinese Imperial Palace.
- Continue on to Jingshan Park for a bird's-eye view of the Forbidden City.
- Visit the Pearl Factory.
- Discover the former royal garden just outside Beijing, the Summer Palace. This is a beautiful expanse of elaborate Qing-style pavilions, bridges, and gardens scattered along the shores of the man-made Kunming Lake.
- End the day with an evening show "The Legend of Kung Fu."

Day 4: Huairou - Beijing

- Travel to the Great Wall of China, the only man made structure visible from space.
- On the way back to Beijing, visit the Ming Dynasty Tombs, which is the burial site of 13 of 17 emperors of the Ming Dynasty.
- Visit the Jade Factory to learn about China's 6000 year old history in jade making.

Day 5: Beijing

- Take a Calligraphy Lesson with a professional calligrapher.
- Visit Olympic Park and see the 2008 Summer Olympic stadium, the Bird's Nest and the aquatics centre, the Water Cube.
- Participate in a Tea Ceremony.
- Enjoy a Hutong Tour, which are residential neighbourhoods that reflect the culture of grassroots Beijingers, and visit a local market.

Day 6: Shanghai

- Travel on a high-speed train to Shanghai.
- Visit with a local family to see what a typical Chinese lifestyle is like

Day 7: Shanghai

- Experience the Jade Buddha Temple, where two jade Buddha statues are housed.
- Explore the Yu Yuan Garden, the largest of Shanghai's ancient gardens.

- Visit the Bund (Zhongshan Dong Yi Lu) which shows off the city's foreign buildings, many of which were erected before 1937.
- Wander down Nanjing Road, China's No. 1 commercial centre.
- End the day with an Acrobatics Show.

Day 8: Shanghai

- Explore the Shanghai World Financial Centre, a massive skyscraper in the Pudong district.
- Visit a Silk Factory to learn about silkworm cultivation and the production of silk thread.
- Wander through the Old French Concession, lined with French colonial-era architecture that has survived unspoiled in the centre of the city.
- Continue on to **Tianzifang**, an arts and crafts enclave.

Day 9: Hong Kong

- Fly to Hong Kong.
- Enjoy an afternoon tour of Kowloon, including a visit to the Garden of Stars, where students can see movie related exhibits.
- Spend the evening watching the Symphony of Lights, a nightly multimedia show involving more than 40 buildings on both sides of the harbour.

Day 10: Hong Kong

- · Visit the Information Centre of Hong Kong Monetary Authority.
- Discover the Tai Po Man Temple, built to mark the founding of the Tai Wo Shi (Tai Wo Market Town).
- Stop by Stanley Market and pay a visit to Victoria Peak, the highest point in Hong Kong Island offering stunning bird's-eye views of the surrounding skyline.
- End the day with a visit to Victoria Bay.

Day 11: Hong Kong

- See one of the largest Buddha statues in the world, the Bronze Giant Buddha, with the Lantau Ngong Ping Tour.
- Visit Po Lin Monastery, one of the most well-established Buddhist monasteries in Hong Kong.
- Walk a short distance to the Wisdom Path, where a series of wooden posts forming a figure eight are engraved with the Heart Sutra.
- The last stop of the tour is Ngong Ping Village, which is built in the old style but has a theme park atmosphere, with souvenir shops, tea houses and fast food outlets.

Day 12: Depart to the airport for your flight home.
