COSTA RICA - 9 Days | Central America Student Tour

Day 1: Board your flight to San José

- Meet your Tour Leader at the airport.
- Enjoy free time in the city with your group. You can wander the streets, head to The National Museum of Costa Rica or relax in La Sabana Metropolitan Park.

Day 2: La Paz - San José

- Travel to La Paz Waterfall Gardens, in the province of Heredia, a private park and rescue centre. You will venture into the lush tropical rainforest to see the spectacular waterfalls, educational animal exhibits and enjoy a buffet lunch with traditional Costa Rican dishes.
- Discover the ancient techniques used by experts producing the best coffee in Costa Rica, on a visit to a coffee plantation. This hands-on process involves the cultivation, harvesting and roasting of the Golden Bean and will finish with a tasting.

Day 3: Sarapiqui

- Travel to Sarapiqui.
- Immerse yourself in the community while you work with a local school on a mini project. Working alongside the students and teachers will build relationships and create a valuable experience for both you and the local students.

Day 4: Sarapiqui

- Chocolate, chocolate, chocolate! Enjoy an educational workshop dedicated to, you guessed it, chocolate. You will learn all about the origin and history of the cacao plant. You will also take a guided tour of an ancient plantation to see the artisanal process and learn the story of pre and post-colonial chocolate.
- Venture into the forest on a **night excursion**. You may see a unique species of frog and other nocturnal animals.

Day 5: La Fortuna - Arenal

- Travel to La Fortuna.
- Visit Arenal National Park to hike along Las Coladas Trail
 and learn the history of the active volcano. On this guided
 tour you will explore the remnants of past eruptions, see the
 local wildlife and encounter astonishing views.
- Free time for lunch in the small village of La Fortuna that sits in the eastern shadow of Arenal volcano, and enjoy time to shop on the commercial streets.
- End the day with a relaxing evening at the Baldi Hot Springs. Enjoy the 25 hot mineral water pools, which flow from the volcano, and soak in the beautiful views.

Day 6: La Fortuna - Manuel Antonio

- Travel towards Quepos.
- Stop at Proyecto Asis Wildlife Centre and hike along trails throughout the reserve. You will learn about the animals and discover its place within the Costa Rican ecosystem.
- Continue on to Manuel Antonio.

Day 7: Manuel Antonio

 Depart for one of the most famous parks in Costa Rica, Manuel Antonio National Park. On this guided tour you will wander along trails through the rainforest to learn about the ecosystem. You may see sloths, various species of birds and reptiles, orchids, butterflies and tropical trees. You can also spend time on the world famous Third Beach.

Day 8: Manuel Antonio

 Spend the day enjoying the beautiful beach and the facilities of the hotel.

Day 9: Depart to the airport for your flight home.
