GREECE & ITALY - 10 Days | European Student Tour

Day 1: Board your flight to Athens

Day 2: Athens

- Meet your Tour Leader at the airport.
- Enjoy free time for lunch.
- Explore the city with a guided tour where you will see the only stadium in the world built entirely of marble, the Panathenaic Stadium, the National Library and the Temple of Olympian Zeus, which was once the largest temple in Greece.

Day 3: Epidaurus - Mycenae - Corinth - Nafplio

- Start the day travelling along the **Argolis Peninsula**.
- Visit Epidaurus, one of the most beautiful sites of classical Greece.
- Discover the secrets behind the production of olive oil at a plantation. You will even get to taste the oil at the end of the guided tour!
- Head over to Mycenae, the civilization that dominated the world of the eastern Mediterranean from the 15th - 13th century BC, to see the imposing ruins.
- Travel to the city of Nafplio to see the castle of Palamidi.
 The fortress was built in the 18th century and has eight strongholds that bear the names of Greek heroes.
- Head to Corinth.

Day 4: Corinth - Delphi

- Explore the **ancient city of Corinth**, which was a very busy trading city and was the site of many ancient myths.
- Discover the **Doric temple**, where you will see a stunning view of the **Gulf of Corinth**.
- Visit the archeological site of Acrocorinth. This site was occupied continuously from archaic times to the early 19th century and the fortress sits the highest point of the city.
- Travel to Delphi for the night.

Day 5: Delphi - Athens

- Start the day with a guided tour of Delphi. The city is one of the most important archaeological sites in Greece and has shown traces of human existence dating back to 12,000 BC.
- Travel to Athens.
- Explore the Acropolis of Athens with whisper headsets.
 This ancient citadel is located on a rocky outcrop above
 the city and contains the remains of several buildings of
 architectural and historic significance, the most famous
 being the Parthenon.

 Visit the Acropolis Museum to see a remarkable collection of Archaic works, including the statue of Moschophoros bearing a sacrificial calf.

Day 6: Rome

- Board your flight to Rome, Italy.
- Enjoy a dinner in the city before heading back to the hotel for the night.

Day 7: Pompeii - Rome

- Travel to the ancient city of Pompeii, the most famous archaeological site in Italy.
- Take a guided tour of the city that was dramatically and brusquely interrupted in 79 AD when Vesuvius erupted and buried it.
- Enjoy a short hike to the top of the Vesuvio volcano and marvel at the view.
- Return to Rome for the evening.

Day 8: Vatican City - Rome

- Travel to Vatican City and explore the museums. You will see one of the greatest art collections in the world, Michelangelo's legendary Sistine Chapel, a marvel of artistic creation and St. Peter's Basilica, a Renaissance church that is an architectural phenomenon and has the largest interior of any Christian church.
- Return to your hotel for the evening.

Day 9: Rome

- Start the day with a guided tour of ancient Rome. You will see the Colosseum, the elliptical amphitheater that showed barbaric Roman entertainment. You will then take a short climb to the top of Palatine Hill to look down on the Forum, the center of Roman parliament and Circus Maximus, the most well-known stadium for chariot racing.
- In the afternoon enjoy a tour of Baroque Rome to see the Spanish Steps at the Piazza di Spagna, the Trevi Fountain and the famous River Fountain, one of Bernini's Baroque masterpieces.

Day 10: Depart for the airport for your flight home.
