Day 1: Board your flight to Iceland.

Day 2: Reykjanesbær - Reykjavík

- Meet your Tour Leader at the airport.
- Start the day with an energizing Scandinavian breakfast at Viking Café.
- Visit Vikingaheimar, the Viking World museum which is home to the Viking Ship The Icelander, the replica of the famous Gokstad ship and the Viking Millennium Exhibition.
- Travel to Reykjavík for a sightseeing drive. You will see the old town centre, Parliament, the National Museum and Höfði house. You will also drive past Laugardalur, an outdoor swimming pool heated by natural hot springs under the city, the Ásmundur Sveinsson Sculpture museum and the Hallgrímskirkja Church.
- The last stop of the day you will learn about the northern lights at the **Aurora Reykjavik**.

Day 3: Hveragerði - Gullfoss - Þingvellir - Reykjavík

- Drive over the Hellisheiði plateau to the greenhouse village Hveragerði.
- Continue on to **Gullfoss**, the Golden Waterfall, one of the most impressive waterfalls in Europe.
- A few minutes down the road is the famous Great Geyser and Strokkur, the most active geyser in the area.
- Travel to **Þingvellir** the world's oldest democratic parliament, the largest lake on the island and the meeting point of two tectonic plates.

Day 4: Hveragerði - Reynisfjara - Kirkjubæjarklaustur -Skaftafell

- Travel along the south shore for an overnight trip to **Skaftafell.**
- Briefly stop in at **Hveragerði** before proceeding east through small villages and farmlands to the majestic mountains towering over the coast. You will see the country's most active volcano, **Hekla** and the large, ice capped strato volcano, **Eyjafjallajökull.**

• Continue through the region and stop at the spectacular waterfalls **Seljalandsfoss** and **Skógarfoss**.

- Next stop is Reynisfjara beach where we will see basalt column formations, volcanic black sand and the Arctic Ocean.
- Stop in to Kirkjubæjarklaustur for lunch.
- End the day at **Skaftafell National Park**, an area dominated by spectacular views of the mighty **Vatnajökull**, Europe's largest glacier.

Day 5: Skaftafell - Jökulsárlón - Reykjavik

- Start the day exploring the Skaftafell area.
- Journey on to **Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon** where huge icebergs float and grind together.
- Sail among the icebergs on the **Amphibian boat tour**. You will get to taste 1000 year old ice and may even see some seals.
- End the day with an educational film at **The Cinema** or the **Volcano House**.

Day 6: Álftanes - Hafnarfjörður- Krísuvík - Grindavik

- Drive to the Álftanes peninsula and pass the residence of Iceland's President at Bessastaðir.
- On the way to Lake Kleifaryatn, we will stop in the town Hafnarfjörður, situated picturesquely on an ancient lava flow.
- At the lake's southern end lies **Krísuyík**, a geothermal field. You will see innumerable small hot springs, mud pots and boiling pools.
- Proceed to the town of Grindavik.
- The last stop on the tour is the **Blue Lagoon**. The water is pleasantly warm and mineral-rich, situated in the middle of a black lava field. Enjoy a swim in this famous geothermal pool.
- After relaxing in the lagoon, the group will be dropped off at **Keflavik International Airport** to depart for home.
