



## IRELAND & SCOTLAND - 9 Days | European Student Tour

#### Day 1: Board your flight to Dublin

#### Day 2: Dublin

- Meet your Tour Leader at the airport.
- Experience the charm of Dublin with a city tour.
   You will see the oldest university in Ireland, Trinity
   College, Grafton Street and the Irish houses
   of Parliament.
- Learn Gaelic games at a GAA Club called "Na Fianna." Students will also cover Gaelic football, hurling and handball on the all-weather pitches.

#### Day 3: Dublin

- Start the day with a guided tour of **Dublin Castle**. Its elegant Georgian courtyard and grand state apartments held the seat of the British rule in Ireland until 1922.
- Explore the Guinness Storehouse, a historical seven floor building that tells the rich history of the brand starting with its birth at St James's Gate in Dublin.
- Visit St. Patrick's Cathedral, a medieval building that is still in use today.

#### Day 4: Belfast

- Travel to Belfast from Dublin.
- Wander through the city on a guided tour and see
   Crumlin Road Gaol and St Georges Market.
- Discover the **Titanic Belfast** and relive the story from the very beginning.

#### Day 5: Glasgow - Edinburgh

- Transfer to **Scotland** on a ferry and make your way to **Glasgow**.
- Explore Kelvingrove Art Gallery and Museum on a guided tour, which has 22 themed galleries displaying an astonishing 8000 objects.
- Continue on to Edinburgh.

#### Day 6: Edinburgh

 Enjoy a full day tour of the city, featuring the medieval Old Town, Edinburgh Castle, the historic fortress that dominates the skyline and offers spectacular views, and the Georgian New Town.

#### Day 7: St. Andrews - Edinburgh

- Join a guided tour of the Old Course, the world's most famous golf course (seasonal availability).
- Visit St. Andrews Castle, which was a bishop's palace, a fortress, and a state prison during its 450-year history.
- Explore the remains of St. Andrews Cathedral,
   Scotland's largest and most magnificent church.

#### Day 8: Edinburgh

- Start the day with a visit to the Palace of Holyroodhouse, the Queen's official residence in Scotland.
- Visit **Dynamic Earth**, an interactive adventure where you will experience the lifespan of our planet.
- Discover Edinburgh's chilling past with an evening ghost tour through Old Town and the Blair Street Underground Vaults.

Day 9: Depart to the airport for your flight home.
