Day 1: Board your flight to Venice.

Day 2: Venice

- Meet your Tour Leader at the airport.
- Enjoy a half-day guided walking tour of Venice where you will see the Bridge of Sighs, Doges Palace, Rialto Bridge lined with rows of shops, and the famous Piazza San Marco. Spend time snacking on Venetian pastries in one of the sidewalk cafés.

Day 3: Murano - Venice

- Perform during the Mass at Basilica San Marco.
- Travel by vaporetto (waterbus) to the island of Murano to watch Venetian Murano glass blowing.
- Spend the rest of the day enjoying the sights of Venice. You may like to visit the Peggy Guggenheim Museum. This modern art collection is considered one of the most comprehensive in the Western World.

Day 4: Florence

- Travel to Florence.
- Take a walking tour of the city where you will see the Arno River, the Piazza della Repubblica, a square in the centre of Florence surrounded with cafés and elegant restaurants, the Piazza della Signoria, the Duomo, and the Pitti Palace, which houses several important museums.

Day 5: Florence

- Start the day with a guided tour of the **Uffizi Gallery**, which was bequeathed to the people of Tuscany by the last grand duchess of the Medici family when she died. Today it contains the finest collection of art in all of Italy.
- Visit the Galleria dell'Accademia, a gallery where you can see the Tuscan masters Botticelli and Perugino, but most famously Michelangelo's David.
- Leisure time to explore **Florence**, take the time to see the sights you may have missed like the **Church of Santa Croce** that holds Giotto's frescoes and the tombs of Michelangelo, Galileo and Machiavelli.

You can also bargain for leather, raffia, art reproduction, and more at the open-air market **Mercato Nuovo**. Don't forget to rub Porcellino's nose for good fortune.

Day 6: Rome

- Travel to Rome.
- Enjoy a guided tour of Ancient Rome. Start with the Colosseum, the elliptical amphitheatre which was the largest of its kind built during the Roman Empire. After exiting the Colosseum, take a short climb to the top of Palatine Hill to look down on the Forum, and Circus Maximus, the most famous stadium for chariot racing.
- **Perform** at the **All Saints Church**, the **Pantheon**, or another **public venue**.

Day 7: Vatican City

- Travel to Vatican City and explore the museums. You will see one of the greatest art collections in the world, amazing artifacts, and Michelangelo's legendary Sistine Chapel, a marvel of artistic creation.
- Visit St. Peter's Basilica for a guided tour, a Renaissance church that is an architectural phenomenon and has the largest interior of any Christian church. Perform during the 5 p.m. Mass at St. Peter's.

Day 8: Rome

- Enjoy an evening walking tour of Baroque Rome where you will see the Spanish Steps at the Piazza di Spagna, the Trevi Fountain and the famous River Fountain, one of Bernini's Baroque masterpieces.
- Perform at the AMBRIT Rome International School.
- Enjoy a farewell dinner at a local restaurant to have the perfect ending to your Italian adventure.

Day 9: Depart to the airport for your flight home.
