LONDON - 7 Days | Student Art Tour

Day 1: Board your flight to London.

Day 2: London

- Meet your Tour leader at the airport and make your way into the city centre.
- Mind the Gap! Your students will get the true London experience with their London Transport Pass for Zones 1 and 2.
- Start your visit with a guided coach tour of London; from Whitehall and Westminster to Fleet Street and St. Paul's.
- Enjoy a Street Art walking tour to see the works of Banksy and other London street artists.

Day 3: London

- Make your way down the Mall to Buckingham Palace where you may be lucky enough to witness the Changing of the Guards.
- Visit the Royal Academy of Arts to see Queen Victoria's paint box and the only Michelangelo sculpture in the UK.
- Partake in the tradition of Afternoon Tea. Replenish your energy with finger sandwiches, scones with jam and clotted cream and the best tea ever! You can even do this while floating down the Thames on a river cruise.

Dav 4: London

- Head to Chelsea and visit the Tate Britain. Walk through the history of British art from the 1500s to the present day.
- In the afternoon, take a tour of **South Bank** and enjoy a visit of the **Tate Modern**, Britain's national museum of modern and contemporary art. See the works of artists including Picasso, Rothko, Dali, and Matisse in this former power plant sitting grandly on the banks of the Thames.
- Take a flight on the **London Eye**, the world's largest Ferris wheel and one of the most popular attractions in the UK. A ride will give an amazing 360° view over London.

Day 5: London

- Head to Trafalgar Square to see everything from the iconic lions flanking Nelson's column to the street performers.
 Make your way up to the National Gallery, which houses masterpieces from da Vinci and Michelangelo to Turner and Constable.
- Visit the Portrait Gallery to explore the history of Great Britain through the portraits of everyone from King Henry the VIII to the Beatles and Diana, Princess of Wales.

- Enjoy a trip to the Tower of London, an object of fear for over 900 years. Today, you can see the famous ravens, the Crown Jewels, and follow a Beefeater on a tour of the grounds.
- · Visit the trendy **Brick Lane** OR explore **Camden Town**.

Day 6: London

- Start your day with a visit to the **Courtauld Gallery**. This collection, housed in the magnificent Somerset House, includes paintings, drawings and more from the medieval period to the present day.
- Free time this afternoon for shopping at Fortnum and Mason or Harrods; or visiting Notting Hill and Petticoat Lane for some thrifting.
- Enjoy a farewell dinner as your art adventure in London draws to a close.

Day 7: Depart for the airport for your flight home.
