LONDON - 7 Days | Student Music Tour

Day 1: Board your flight to London.

Day 2:

- Meet your Tour Leader at the airport.
- Enjoy a coach tour of London with a local guide where you will see Whitehall and Westminster, Fleet Street, and St. Paul's Cathedral.
- Continue your day with a Beatles Walking Tour.
- Explore Soho and Chinatown.

Day 3:

- Visit Buckingham Palace. If you're lucky, you'll be able to watch the Changing of the Guard ceremony!
- Walk through Kensington to the Royal Albert Hall for a Behind the Scenes Tour of this concert venue.
- Participate in the tradition of Afternoon Tea with finger sandwiches, scones, jam, and clotted cream.
- Return to the Royal Albert Hall to attend a concert!

Day 4:

- Head to the Tower of London! Enjoy a tour of the grounds from the London Beefeaters. See the famous ravens, the Crown Jewels, and more!
- Cross the Tower Bridge and explore the South Bank. Visit the Borough Market, a historic wholesale fruit and vegetable market in medieval times.
- Take a flight on the London Eye, Europe's largest ferris wheel and one of the most popular attractions in the UK.
- Attend a performance of a West End musical.

Day 5:

- Head to Trafalgar Square to see everything from Nelson's Column to street performers. Climb the stairs to the National Gallery to see pieces by da Vinci, Michelangelo, Turner, Constable, and more!
- Attend a lunchtime concert at the Church of St. Martin-in-the-Fields.
- Visit the National Portrait Gallery to explore the history of Great Britain and the world through the portraits hanging here.
- Explore the trendy Brick Lane area of London's East End.

Day 6:

- Visit Convent Garden and the Royal Opera House, for a tour of this celebrated venue
- Perform at one of London's Galleries or churches.
- Enjoy a farewell dinner at a local restaurant as your London art adventure comes to an end.
