MANITOULIN ISLAND - 3 Days | Northern Ontario Student Tour

DAY 1

7:30 a.m. **Board your motor coach and depart.** Appropriate rest and meal stops will be made. En route, your Tour Leader will get to know the students and lead discussions.

2:30 p.m. Cup and Saucer Hike. Part of the Niagara Escarpment World Biosphere Reserve, the Cup and Saucer Trail is named for its unique rock shapes. Spectacular views await you!

5:00 p.m. Hotel check-in

6:00 p.m. Dinner

7:00 p.m. Welcome to Manitoulin & Introduction to Smudging and Sacred Medicine Teachings. Learn the meaning and significance of the Medicine Wheel and Smudging, which are an integral part of many Indigenous cultures, during this workshop.

DAY 2

8:00 a.m. Breakfast

10:00 a.m. The Unceded Journey. Learn the history of Odawa Mnis (Manitoulin Island) and Wiikwemkoong Unceded Territory on this guided tour. You will marvel at the views of Manitowaning Bay from the Buzwah Lookout. Learn about the history of the Jesuits as you visit the oldest Catholic church in northern Ontario and make a stop at Holy Cross Mission Ruins, a residential school site.

12:30 p.m. Packed lunch

2:00 p.m. Traditional Culinary Experience. Participate in traditional culinary methods with sampling to follow.

6:00 p.m. Dinner

7:00 p.m. Community Drum Social. Enjoy an introduction to an interactive Drum Social, featuring Rolling Thunder dance traditions.

DAY 3

7:00 a.m. Breakfast

8:00 a.m. Check out of your hotel and load your luggage into your motor coach.

9:00 a.m. Guided Tour at the Ojibway Cultural Foundation.

Learn about culture, spirituality, and traditions of the Anishinaabe people of Mnidoo Mnising and the surrounding areas. Begin to understand the legacy of the residential school system through art, language, songs, and stories.

10:15 a.m. **Bridal Falls Walk and Nature Trail.** This beautiful waterfall is more than 10 metres in height, fed from interior Lake Kagawong.

11:30 a.m. Visit Kagawong. Learn of Kagawong history as you visit the Old Mill Heritage Centre, Kagawong Lighthouse, and the St. John the Evangelist Anglican Church. Explore local shops, including Manitoulin Chocolate Works and Boo-Bah-Lou Candy Cabin!
