DAY 1

- **7:30 a.m. Board the motor coach** (washroom-equipped & climate-controlled) and depart for New York City. En route your Tour Leader will get to know the group on a first name basis.
- **9:00 a.m. Border Crossing.** Make sure your passport and any other important documents are in a safe and accessible place for border agents.

8:00 p.m. Times Square. Head to the heart of the Great White Way and be amazed by the bright lights and massive screens. Join the crowds on the famous Red Stairs and get caught up in the excitement as your wander through the square.

DAY 2

8:00 a.m. Breakfast

- 10:30 a.m. Guided tour of the Lincoln Center including the three main theatres: the Metropolitan Opera House, Avery Fisher Hall, and the New York State Theatre. Students will hear stories of great artists, great builders, and great institutions.
- 12:00 p.m. Central Park Orientation Tour. This iconic park, which is the most filmed location in the world, is a green oasis in the middle of the city. You will see Strawberry Fields, the memorial to John Lennon, the Alice in Wonderland sculpture and Rat Rock, a crop of large boulders left over by receding glaciers.

1:30 p.m. Lunch

- **4:00 p.m. Stage Door Tour of Radio City Music Hall.** Learn about the legendary events and shows that have taken place on the Great Stage, and admire the vast Radio City art collection. Go backstage and explore the costume shop, production areas, and meet a world famous Rockette.
- 6:30 p.m. Dinner and jazz evening.


- 8:30 a.m. Breakfast

- **3:00 p.m. THE RIDE.** Groups experience the surprise of improv comedy, the songs and voices of Broadway, the facts of a city sights tour, and the memory of a lifetime in this theatrical show and immersive tour.
- **5:00 p.m. Rockefeller Center and 5th Avenue.** Visit New York's most famous street to shop and browse along 5th Avenue and Rockefeller Center.

- 8:00 p.m. Visit Top of the Rock. Experience unparalleled views of New York City from the Observation Deck on the 70th floor of 30 Rockefeller Plaza, in the heart of midtown Manhattan.

- **10:00 a.m.** Visit the 9/11 Memorial. "Reflecting Absence" are twin reflecting pools that sit within the footprints of the towers. Your students will learn about the events of this day and will pay respects to the nearly 3,000 people who died in the terror attacks on September 11, 2001 and the six people killed during the bombing in February 1993.
- **11:30 a.m. Greenwich Village.** Start your tour at Washington Square then explore the café, bars, and side streets of this iconic neighbourhood. Lunch on your own in the area.
- **2:00 p.m.** Walk along the High Line. Experience New York City's architecture and biodiversity as you walk along the old rail tracks 30ft above street level. This gorgeous walk runs through the Meatpacking District, Chelsea and Hell's Kitchen with many stops along the way for photos!

5:15 p.m. Dinner

8:00 p.m. Watch a Broadway Show. Explore a whole new world, discover what came before the yellow brick road or sing along with your favourite meerkat and warthog duo. Theatre tickets are subject to schedule and availability.
