9:15 p.m. Visit Top of the Rock. Experience unparalleled views of New York City from the 70th floor Observation Deck of 30 Rock! Enjoy the best view in the city of the Empire State Building.

DAY 2

8:15 a.m. Breakfast

10:00 a.m. Stage Door Tour of Radio City Music Hall. Learn about the legendary events that have taken place on this storied stage during a fascinating, behind-the-scenes tour of Radio City Music Hall. Explore the costume shop, production areas, and even meet a world-famous Rockette!

7:30 p.m. Times Square. No trip to New York is complete without a stop in Times Square. Be captivated by the massive screens, lights, and hustle and bustle of this historic square! Can you spot the New Year's Ball?

DAY 3

8:15 a.m. Breakfast

10:00 a.m. **Modelling Agency Tour.** Visit a modelling agency and learn the different functions the agency performs with models.

12:15 p.m. Lower Manhattan Orientation Tour. Experience Lower Manhattan with your Tour Leader.

12:30 p.m. Lunch

1:30 p.m. Visit the 9/11 Memorial. "Reflecting Absence" are twin reflecting pools that sit within the footprints of the towers. Learn about the events and pay respects to the nearly 3,000 people who died in the terror attacks on

September 11, 2001, and the six people killed during the bombing in February 1993.

2:00 p.m. Information Session at the Fashion Institute of Technology. These Admissions Information Sessions are designed to give students all the information they need to apply to FIT. There will be an opportunity to ask questions of an Admissions Counsellor.

3:30 p.m. Visit The Museum at FIT. The Museum at FIT is one of the only institutions dedicated to the study of fashion and textiles. View the social and cultural changes that fashion so clearly demonstrates.

5:00 p.m. Dinner

6:00 p.m. Walk along the High Line. Experience the city's architecture and biodiversity as you walk along the old rail tracks, located 10 metres above street level. Walk through the Meatpacking District and Chelsea to Hell's Kitchen. Many photo opps along the way!

10:00 a.m. Macy's Fashion Tour. Let a Macy's fashion specialist guide you through the trending brands and designers, right off the runway! Receive wardrobe styling tips and help to create your own unique look.
