

PARIS & NORMANDY - 8 Days | Economical European Student Tour

Day 1: Board your flight to Paris

Day 2: Étretat - Pont-l'Evêque - Caen

- Arrive at Charles de Gaulle International Airport and meet your Tour Leader
- Travel towards the beautiful region of Normandy.
- Don't forget your camera! Our first stop is at the chalky cliffs of Étretat for some fresh air. Stretch your legs as you hike to the foot of the gorgeous gate of Aval.
- You can't go all the way to France without trying cheese. Head to Pont-l'Evêque to watch a 10-minute movie about the origins of their namesake and enjoy a tasting of this creamy cheese.
- Next stop Caen.
- End the day with beloved French dishes, a sweet crêpe or savory galette, for dinner.

Day 3: Juno Beach - Berniéres - Beny-sur-Mer - Caen

- Start the day at the Caen Memorial, and the interactive museum that focuses on the events that led to WWII.
- Depart for your half-day tour of the Canadian landing beaches.
- Begin your journey at the Juno Beach Centre to see several exhibits that mark the efforts of Canadian soldiers during World War II. You will also see Juno Park and part of the famous Atlantic Wall.
- Explore an underground bunker, German Command Post, tunnel and Observation Post that served as a German strong point against the Royal Winnipeg Rifles.
- Walk over to the village of Berniéres where you will see Canada House, one of the first homes to be liberated by the Canadians on June 6th, 1944.
- · Continue towards Saint-Aubin sur Mer.
- Visit the Canadian Military Cemetery in Bény-sur-Mer and pay respect to the soldiers killed during the early stages of the Battle of Normandy.
- Last stop on the tour takes you to the Ardenne Abbey where your guide will explain the tragic events that took place here on June 7th. 1944.
- Return to Caen for the night to experience a Normandy style dinner.

Day 4: Mont Saint-Michel - St Malo

- Depart for Mont Saint-Michel, an architectural marvel nestled on an island in the middle of the bay.
- Follow your Tour Leader through the medieval village to learn about the fascinating history of this architectural marvel and see the ramparts and Grande-Rue.
- Visit the Benedict Abbey of Mont Saint-Michel. Declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1979, this stunning building sits at the very top of the island and offers beautiful views both inside and out.
- Travel to St Malo.
- Join your Tour Leader for a stroll through the fortified city. This
 coastal town was founded in the 1st century and has a Canadian
 connection—it is the birthplace of explorer Jacques Cartier.

- Enjoy a meal of Breton specialties with your group.
- End the day with a sunset walk along the ramparts with your Tour Leader. Grab your camera, this is a perfect time for a group photo!

Day 5: Versailles - Paris

- Depart for Paris.
- Stop in at Versailles for a tour of the Palace of Versailles. Your audio guide will take you through its history as you wander through the Grand Apartment, the Hall of Mirrors and the King and Queen's suites.
- Get lost in the stunning gardens of Versailles, which are landscaped in the French style, and date back to the reign of Louis XIV.
- Continue to **Paris**, where you will be living like a Parisian with a 5-day **metro pass** for Zones 1-3.
- Feeling daring? Soar to the top of the **Eiffel Tower** for breathtaking views of the city.

Day 6: Paris

- Start the day with a 3-hour guided tour of the City of Lights. You
 will meet in the gardens of the Palais-Royal and continue on to see
 the Place de la Concord, where King Louis XVI and Marie Antoinette
 were publicly executed, the Tuileries and the lively Latin Quarter.
- Head to Sainte-Chapelle to explore the beautiful stained glass windows in this gothic church.
- Make sure you have good walking shoes, next stop is the hilly Montmartre. Stoll through this charming neighbourhood to see the Basilica Sacré Cœur from the top of the hill, the Wall of Love and the Moulin Rouge.
- End the day with an authentic French meal with your group.

Day 7: Paris

- Start your day with a special audio guide tour of the Musée du Louvre. A Nintendo 3DS will lead you through this maze to see the iconic Mona Lisa, and other masterpieces along the way.
- Make your way to the reverse pyramid at the Carrousel du Louvre on your free time.
- Stroll down one of the most famous streets in the world, the Champs Elysées and see the stunning Arc de Triomphe.
- It's time for shopping! Explore the Grands Boulevards, especially Boulevard Haussmann and its famous department stores, le Printemps and les Galeries Lafayette.
- All aboard! Savour the last bit of Paris as you listen to a commentary while cruising along the Seine on one of the famous Bateaux-Mouches.

Day 8: Depart to the airport for your flight home.
