QUÉBEC CITY - 4 Days | Winter Wonderland Student Tour

DAY 1

7:00 a.m. Board your washroom equipped, climate controlled highway motor coach and depart for Québec City via Highway #407. En route, your Tour Leader will get to know the students on a first name basis.

8:00 a.m. Participate in The Adventure! What time is it?

Adventure Time! This Brightspark Exclusive spans the entire trip to keep your students engaged. 5:30 p.m. Hotel check-in

7:00 p.m. Dinner

8:00 p.m. Orientation Walk of Upper Town. Experience the city as it was in the days of New France. Your Tour Leader will guide your through the upper half of the UNESCO World Heritage Site to see Cannon Ball Tree, Rue de Tresor, or Artist Alley, and the iconic Château Frontenac.

10:00 p.m. **Night security** each evening between 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a m

DAY 2

8:30 a.m. Breakfast

10:00 a.m. Immersion Québec. The group will rotate through two stations in which they are given a tablet or a virtual reality headset to either take part in a friendly competition or view Québec's live history in 30 minutes.

11:30 a.m. Lunch

1:15 p.m. Orientation Walk of Lower Town. Experience the city as it was in the days of New France. Your Tour Leader will take you through the lower half of the UNESCO World Heritage Site to see the Place Royale, and Fresque du Petit-Champlain.

2:00 p.m. Sliding on the Dufferin Terrace. Hold on to your hats!

Sitting at the base of the Château Frontenac, this unique slide, which first appeared in 1884, reaches speeds of 70km/h. Enjoy the view of the St. Lawrence River as you glide down the ice with your students.

3:30 p.m. Soldier of the Martello Tower. Accompanied by British officers, learn all about the soldiers living in Martello Tower in 1812 and experience the military lifestyle through competitions and games.

5:30 p.m. French Canadian Dinner at Érablière du Lac Beauport.
Enjoy a traditional sugar shack meal followed by lively folk music, dancing and maple taffy served on snow. You will also visit the maple sugar museum and the trapper camp where you will learn about the ancient and modern techniques of Québec trappers.

DAY 3

7:00 a.m. Breakfast

8:00 a.m. Quel Beau Pré! Explore the route to Nouvelle France and the people that inhabited the coast throughout history. As you drive along this historic coastline, your students will learn about a few of the important figures that once called this area home.

9:45 a.m. Self-Guided Visit of Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré Basilica.

Discover the Romanesque cathedral that began as a shrine to honour Saint Anne. Every year hundreds of thousands of tourists and pilgrims visit this impressive church where miracles are still believed to occur.

11:15 a.m. Visit Montmorency Falls. Stop at one of the most spectacular natural wonders of the Beaupre Coast, Montmorency Falls! Students will explore the top and bottom of the falls and the brave can get photos from the middle of a suspension bridge spanning the top of the falls.

12:15 p.m. Les Galeries de la Capitale. The group can shop and explore Les Galeries de la Capitale with 252 stores and the Mega Parc, complete with a roller coaster, Ferris wheel, an ice-skating track, and a full arcade.

12:30 p.m. Lunch

2:00 p.m. Guided Tour at the Traditional Huron Site -Onhoüa Chetek8e. Journey into the heart of Huron traditions, where students will discover their ancient way of life on a guided tour of the reconstructed Huron Village. Visit a longhouse and learn about the transportation, food preparation and spirituality of the Huron-Wendat people.

4:30 p.m. Self-Guided Tour of the Ice Hotel. It might look like you've been transported to Narnia, but you are actually at the Hôtel de Glace! This dazzling hotel is rebuilt out of ice every year for a unique experience your students will never forget.

5:30 p.m. Village Vacances Valcartier Snow Park. Test your courage as you sail down the 110 foot tall Everest snow slide. Your students will receive access to all activities at Valcartier Village which includes 42 different snow slides, and snow rafts that fit up to 12 people!
