QUÉBEC CITY AND MONTRÉAL - 5 Days | Québec Winter Student Tour

11:00 a.m. Arrive in Montréal. Your Tour Leader will meet you at the airport

12:00 p.m. Board your motor coach and depart for Québec City. 3:30 p.m. Guided tour of the Citadelle/Royal 22e Régiment Museum. Built by the British following the war of 1812, La Citadelle is the fortress home of the Royal 22e Régiment. A guided tour introduces students to the Citadelle's history and that of the "Vandoos".

4:30 p.m. Orientation Walk of Upper Town. Experience the city as it was in the days of New France. Your Tour Leader will take you through the upper half of the UNESCO World Heritage Site to see Cannon Ball Tree, Rue de Trésor "Artist Alley", and the iconic Château Frontenac.

5:30 p.m. Dinner

7:00 p.m. Sliding on the Dufferin Terrace. Whoosh down ice-covered tracks on a wooden toboggan over a distance of 250 metres. Les Glissades de la Terrasse was built more than 100 years ago and was one of the first rides of its kind, anywhere in the world.

DAY 2

8:30 a.m. Breakfast

10:00 a.m. Orientation Walk of Lower Town. Explore the lower half of the UNESCO World Heritage Site to see the Place Royale, and Fresque du Petit-Champlain.

10:45 a.m. Sound and Light Presentation at Musée du Fort. The Musée du Fort takes you on an extraordinary journey in time with a sound and light show that recounts the military history of Québec City.

11:30 a.m. Old Québec Exploration. Opportunity to explore Old Québec in small groups. Visit rue du Trésor, the street of artists, and the many shops and boutiques.

12:00 p.m. Lunch

1:00 p.m. Guided Tour of the Ice Hotel. A one-of-a-kind in North America, the Ice Hotel is a unique place to visit and a perfect stop for interesting photos.

2:00 p.m. Village Vacances Valcartier. Snow Tube down your choice of 42 different snow slides or raft downhill with a group of friends. 8:00 a.m. Breakfast Be sure to test your courage on the 110-foot-tall Everest!

6:00 p.m. French Canadian Dinner at Érablière du Lac Beauport. Enjoy a traditional sugar shack meal followed by lively folk music, dancing and maple taffy served on snow. You will also visit the maple sugar museum and the trapper camp where you will learn about the ancient and modern techniques of Québec trappers.

DAY 3

7:45 a.m. Breakfast

8:15 a.m. Quel Beau Pré! Explore the route to Nouvelle France and the people that inhabited the coast throughout history. As you drive along this historic coastline, your students will learn about a few of the important figures that once called this area home.

9:00 a.m. Visit Montmorency Falls. Stop at one of the most spectacular natural wonders of the Beaupré Coast.

10:00 a.m. Self-Guided Visit Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré Basilica. Discover the Romanesque cathedral that began as a shrine to honour Saint Anne.

11:30 a.m. Lunch

1:30 p.m. Intro to Dogsledding. Lead a team of Alaskan Malamutes over Québec's snowy terrain, then switch with a friend and ride in style as you participate in one of the most Canadian of winter activities, dogsledding!

3:00 p.m. Board your motor coach and depart for Montréal.

5:00 p.m. Dinner

6:30 p.m. Cosmic Bowling at Salon de Quilles Montmorency. Challenge your classmates and teachers to see who gets top score at a local bowling alley. Includes shoe rental.
