- 11:30 a.m. Bread and Maple Butter at Chez Marie. In a stone dwelling dating back to 1652, treat yourself to delicious bread, baked fresh daily, and topped with their famous, homemade maple butter.
- 12:15 p.m. Workshop at the Albert Gilles Copper Museum. Visit the exhibition of 50 hand-wrought silver panels, executed by the internationally renowned artisan, Albert Gilles. After, experience the technique of "repoussé" with a hands-on copper workshop resulting in pieces students can take home!
