

Day 1: Board your flight to Lisbon.

#### Day 2: Lisbon

- Meet your tour leader at the airport.
- Take a guided tour of the city where you will see the Manueline architectural jewels, the Belem Tower, which is the symbol of Lisbon, and the Jeronimos Monastery.

You will also see the stunning **monument to Henry the Navigator**.

#### Day 3: Lisbon - Faro - Seville

- Travel to the 'capital of the Algarve region,' the resort town of Faro.
- Explore the historic town with a guided tour where you will visit the cobbled street of **Old Town Faro**, the 16th century church of **St. Francisco** and enjoy the views atop the medieval tower of the **Chapel of Santo Antonio do Alto**.
- Head to the seaside for views of the iconic cliffs and beaches of the Algarve.
- Drive to Seville.

#### Day 4: Seville

- Start your day with a guided walking tour visiting the famous **Gypsy Town**, the **Seville Cathedral** and the "icon of Seville" the magnificent **Giralda** (a UNESCO World Heritage Site).
- Experience a tour at one of the most iconic settings in Spain, the 'Plaza de Toros'.

#### Day 5: Gibraltar - Torremolinos

- Travel to the **Rock of Gibraltar**, a colossal limestone peninsula that is Crown property of the United Kingdom.
- Embark on a half day guided Rock Tour and visit St. Michael's Cave, a large natural grotto used for concerts and plays, the Ape's Den, the Moorish Castle and the Garrison Chapel.
- Drive along the southern coast of Spain to Torremolinos.

Day 6: Mijas - Benalmádena - Torremolinos

- Travel to **Mijas**, which was founded in prehistoric times by the Tartessians.
- Explore the town with a guided tour, and see the hermitage site of the Virgen de la Peña, built in 1520 and the Plaza de Toros Oval.
- Discover majestic views of the **Costa del Sol** in a cable car ride that takes you up 3 kilometres.

#### Day 7: Granada - Torremolinos

- Travel to **Granada**, the favourite city of Moorish Kings.
- Take a guided tour of the city with entrances to the Alhambra Palace and Fortress, which is considered the most beautiful palace built by the Moors and the Cathedral of Granada.
- Return to Torremolinos.

#### Day 8: Madrid

- Depart for Madrid.
- Enjoy a **Flamenco** show, a Spanish art form made up of guitar playing, song and dance.

#### Day 9: Madrid

- Start the day with a guided tour of Madrid, the capital city of Spain. Highlights include Museo del Prado, Spain's national art museum, Mercado de San Miguel, a market known as the Cultural Culinary Centre of Madrid, Restaurante Sobrino de Botin, the 'oldest restaurant in the world'' and Plaza de la Villa, an intimate square with buildings dating back to the Middle Ages.
- Enjoy a paella cooking class followed by dinner (you'll eat what you've cooked!).

Day 10: Depart to the airport for your flight home.
