VANCOUVER & VICTORIA - 5 Days | West Coast Student Tour

DAY 1

7:30 a.m. Board your motor coach and depart for Vancouver.

Appropriate rest and meal stops will be made. En route, your Tour Leader will get to know the students and lead discussions.

12:30 p.m. Lunch

1:30 p.m. Orientation walk of Vancouver. With your Tour Leader, you will see some of the sites that make Vancouver such a beautiful city, including Stanley Park, the Waterfront, Gastown, Granville Street, and Christ Church Cathedral.

5:00 p.m. **Granville Island.** Granville Island is an urban oasis, filled with galleries, studios, fine waterfront restaurants, and a fabulous fresh food market!

DAY 2

7:30 a.m. Breakfast

9:00 a.m. Visit the Capilano Suspension Bridge. Make your way across Vancouver's most famous landmark. Originally built in 1889, the current bridge is 140 metres long and sits 70 metres above the forest floor. Pause in the middle and marvel at this feat of engineering, surrounded by the 300-year-old rainforest.

11:00 a.m. Visit the Capilano River Hatchery. Observe one of the great life-cycle stories as you see young Pacific salmon in the ponds and adult salmon struggling up fish ladders to spawn.

12:30 p.m. Lunch

2:00 p.m. Visit Grouse Mountain. There is no better view of Vancouver than the one you will see from the famous Grouse Mountain Skyride, the largest aerial tramway in North America!

5:00 p.m. Dinner

7:00 p.m. FlyOver Canada. Soar from coast to coast with the latest in-flight ride technology. The special effects will make you feel like you are really flying!

DAY 3

8:00 a.m. Breakfast

9:00 a.m. Check out of your hotel and load your luggage onto your motor coach.

11:00 a.m. Ferry from Tsawwassen to Vancouver Island.

12:35 p.m. Arrive at the Swartz Bay Ferry Terminal and transfer to Victoria.

1:15 p.m. Lunch

3:00 p.m. Visit Craigdarroch Castle. Built by Scottish immigrant and coal baron Robert Dunsmuir during the reign of Queen Victoria, Craigdarroch Castle is now a National Historic Site.

4:30 p.m. Hotel check-in

6:30 p.m. **Dinner**

DAY 4

8:00 a.m. Breakfast

10:00 a.m. Visit the Royal British Columbia Museum. Founded in 1886, the Royal BC Museum merged with the Archives in 2003. This world-class museum houses artefacts, documents, and specimens of British Columbia's natural and human history.

11:30 a.m. Visit Thunderbird Park. Home to many totem poles and other First Nations monuments, the park takes its name from the mythological Thunderbird of Indigenous North American cultures.

12:30 p.m. Lunch and some free time for exploring, shopping, and photo opps around Victoria's Inner Harbour.

3:00 p.m. Guided Tour of the Legislative Assembly of British
Columbia. Tour the Parliament Buildings, home to
the Legislative Assembly of British Columbia, where
elected representatives meet to shape the future of the
province by debating and passing the laws that govern
British Columbia

4:15 p.m. Visit Beacon Hill Park. With more than 200 acres of parkland, Beacon Hill Park has a number of protected, environmentally sensitive areas. It also has the important status of being Mile 0 as the western terminus of the Trans-Canada Highway!

5:30 p.m. **Dinner**

7:00 p.m. Ghostly Walks: Parliament Buildings and Pendray Inn Tour. The ghost of architect Francis Rattenbury is said to stalk the corridors of the Parliament Buildings. The tour ends near the Gatsby Mansion, the haunted former home of the Pendray family, whose paint factory stood on the disturbed First Nations burial ground at nearby Laurel Point.

7:35 a.m. Breakfast

8:00 a.m. Check out of your hotel and load your luggage into your motor coach.

10:00 a.m. Visit Miniature World. Welcome to the Wonderful World of Smallness. Step into storybooks of fact, fiction and fantasy!

1:00 p.m. Ferry from Swartz Bay to Tsawwassen. Enjoy lunch on board.
