Enjoy a guided tour of the Udvar-Hazy Air & Space Museum Annex, where students can walk among aircraft and small artifacts in display cases located on the floor. Among the aviation artifacts on display are the Lockheed SR-71 Blackbird, the fastest jet in the world and the Boeing Dash 80, the prototype of the 707.

11:00 a.m. Lunch and free time in the area.

12:45 p.m. Fashion Centre. Enjoy a world-class shopping experience where avenues of fashions and boulevards of style await. The sky-lit food court features both international and familiar specialties.

2:30 p.m. Guided Walking Tour of Arlington National Cemetery.

Join a guided walking tour of Arlington National
Cemetery. America's largest national burial ground has
more than 200 acres of landscaped hills. Among the
thousands of white headstones are the graves of
President John Kennedy, Supreme Court Justice
Thurgood Marshall, world champion boxer Joe Louis, and
the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.

5:00 p.m. Explore Union Station. The gateway to the U.S. capital city is considered one of the finest examples of Beaux-Arts architecture. Take this opportunity to explore the shops and boutiques.

5:30 p.m. Dinner

6:30 p.m. Illuminated Coach Tour of Washington D.C. Enjoy an evening tour conducted by a professional local guide.
