BOSTON - 4 Days | New England Student Tour

DAY 1

8:00 AM: Board your washroom equipped, climate controlled highway motor coach and depart for Boston. En route, your Tour Leader will go through the bus and get to know the students on a first name basis.

9:40AM: Visit the New England Aquarium where your students will increase their understanding of aquatic life and environments through exhibits that showcase diversity and highlight aquatic issues of importance.

11:30 AM: Quincy Market and Faneull Hall. Enjoy free time to explore Quincy Market and Fanieuil Hall. Lunch on at your

own cost.

1:30 PM: Freedom Trail Walking Tour. Walk along the Freedom Trail and watch costumed characters lead the group through the story of America's founding and the birth of the United States' freedom.

3:15 PM: USS Constitution Warship & Museum. Visit the USS
Constitution Warship & Museum about America's naval
history and the oldest commissioned warship afloat
in the world.

4:30 PM: Stroll through Boston's Public Garden, established in 1837. Highlights and photo opportunities include "Make Way for Ducklings" statue, views of the Boston Swan Boats, and the Suspension Bridge.

Enjoy dinner in the area at individuals cost.

5:00 PM: Dinner

7:00 PM: Boston Harbor Sunset Cruise. View a spectacular sunset of the Boston Harbor with a cruise that adds a whole new dimension to this fully narrated, 90-minute sightseeing tour.

9:30 AM: Fenway Park - Guided Tour. Get a behind-the-scenes look at America's most beloved ballpark, Fenway Park. Groups can visit the press box and broadcast booths the .406 Club, the Dugout Seats, and Pesky's Pole.

11:30 AM: Harvard University Walking Tour. Led by Harvard students, enjoy a walking tour of Harvard University for historical accounts, exclusive takes on student life, and hot-spots.

12:30 PM: Explore the grounds of Harvard University with your Tour Leader. Lunch in the area at individuals cost.

3:00 PM: Visit the Museum of Science for a self-guided tour to explore, learn, and understand through a variety of handson exhibit.

8:00 PM: Skywalk Observatory. Enjoy a 360-deree view of Greater Boston at the Skywalk Observatory, Boston's only sky-high vantage point.
