MONTREAL - 3 Days | Ville-Marie Student Tour

DAY 1

7:00 AM: **Board your** washroom equipped, climate controlled highway **motor coach** and depart for Montreal via Highway #407. En route, your Tour Leader will go through the bus and get to know the students on a first name basis

8:30 PM: Old Montreal Orientation Tour. Your Tour Leader will guide you through Old Montreal to learn about this historic district. Students will see the Notre Dame Cathedral, Place Jacques-Cartier and the oldest skyscraper in Canada, the New York Life Building.

DAY 2

9:45 AM: Mount Royal Lookout. The group will head up to the top of Mount Royal to get a bird's eye view of the city. From the lookout, students will get a great view of the Saint Lawrence River and the Monteregian Hills - the perfect place for pictures!

11:30 AM: Montreal Planetarium Visit. The recently opened Planétarium Rio Tinto Alcan lets students explore the galaxy with two complementary shows, one science based and the other a whimsical journey through time and space. Between shows, students will learn more about astronomy through interactive exhibits.

1:15 PM: Lunch

2:30 PM: Visit and Intro Tour of the Notre Dame Basilica.

Situated in the heart of Old Montreal, Notre Dame is an architectural masterpiece. Students will learn the history of the basilica as they marvel at the gorgeous paintings, sculptures and stained glass.

3:15 PM: Escape the Port: City of Symbols. Head to the heart of Old Montreal to hunt for symbols hidden by generations past. This Brightspark Exclusive brings your students together to help solve a mystery and explore the history of this fascinating city.

6:30 PM: Brightspark Montreal Gala. After a delicious buffet dinner, students will experience our interactive dance party.
