

NEW YORK CITY - 5 Days | Empire City Student Tour

DAY 1

10:00 AM: Board your Flight to New York City. Your Tour Leader will meet the group at the airport.

3:00 PM: Meet your local motor coach and transfer to the city.

4:00 PM: Hotel Check-In

5:00 PM: Orientation Walk of Times Square and Surrounding Area. Marvel at the ubiquitous bill boards and the energy of Times Square as your Tour Leader familiarizes you with this iconic area.

7:00 PM: Dinner

8:30 PM: Visit the Empire State Building Observatory. Groups can soar a quarter of a mile into the atmosphere to get one of the best views of the city.

DAY 2

9:15 AM: Take a Subway Ride. Under the direction of your Tour Leader, the group will take the subway to your next activity.

9:30 AM: Ferry to Liberty and Ellis Islands on Statue Cruises.

Board your ferry and depart for Liberty and Ellis Islands.

See the Statue of Liberty up close and explore America's rich immigration history. Your ticket includes the grounds of Liberty Island and the Ellis Island Museum.

2:00 PM: Lower Manhattan Orientation Tour. Orientation Tour of Lower Manhattan as led by your Tour Leader. Lunch at your own cost.

3:00 PM: Visit the 9/11 Memorial. "Reflecting Absence" are twin reflecting pools that sit within the footprints of the towers. Your students will learn about the events of this day and will pay respect to the nearly 3,000 people who died in the terror attacks on September 11, 2001 and the six people killed during the bombing in February 1993.

6:00 PM: Times Square. A trip to New York is not complete without a stop in Times Square! Be captivated by the massive screens, lights, and hustle and bustle of this historic square. Enjoy a group dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 3

10:00 AM: Guided Tour of the United Nations Headquarters. On a visit to the United Nations Headquarters your international, multilingual guide will introduce and lead discussions about the principles, structure, and activities of the UN.

11:30 AM: **Grand Central Terminal**. Marvel at the beautiful architecture of Grand Central Terminal and explore some of its shops

12:00 PM: Lunch

1:00 PM: Herald Square, 34th Street & Macy's. Explore Herald Square and 34th Street, home to Macy's and many other shops.

3:00 PM: Visit the Museum of Modern Art. The museum seeks to create a dialogue between the established and the experimental, and the past and the present in an environment responsive to issues of modern and contemporary art.

6:00 PM: Dinner

DAY 4

10:00 AM: Visit the American Museum of Natural History & Rose Center. Established in 1869, the American Museum of Natural History is one of the most respected museums in North America. It is the largest science museum in the world, and home to the greatest dinosaur collection anywhere.

12:15 PM: Lunch

1:00 PM: Central Park Orientation Tour. Your Tour Leader will lead the group on a stroll through Central Park, the first landscaped public park in the United States. It is one of the urban wonders of the world: a green oasis in the great concrete, high-rise landscape of New York City.

3:00 PM: Visit The Metropolitan Museum of Art. The Met is one of the world's largest museums and features works dating from ancient Egypt to modern times. In addition to art, you will see musical instruments, costumes and antique weapons from around the world!

6:00 PM: Dinner

8:00 PM: Broadway Show. Enjoy a theatre performance. Subject to schedule and availability.

DAY 5

10:00 AM: Stage Door Tour of Radio City Music Hall. This is a fascinating, behind the scenes, tour of Radio City Music Hall. Learn about the legendary events and shows that have taken place on the Great Stage and admire the vast Radio City art collection. Go backstage and explore the costume shop, production areas and meet a world famous Rockette.

11:30 AM: Rockefeller Center and 5th Avenue. Shop and browse along 5th Avenue and Rockefeller Center. Don't miss viewing St. Patrick's Cathedral.
