- 6:00 PM: French Canadian Dinner at Érablière du Lac Beauport. Enjoy a traditional sugar shack meal followed by lively folk music, dancing and maple taffy served on snow. You will also visit the maple sugar museum and the Trapper camp where you will learn about the ancient and modern techniques of Quebec trappers.
