Now enter your username and password and click Connect. If you get a warning about the certificate you can click always trust







Complete the sign in with DUO.

You can disconnect from the VPN when you are finished. The next time you connect, it should default to the Server: sslvpn.ais-ins.com:4433. If not simply choose it from the drop down.

Optional step – remove the old connection:

When the connection is idle click on the wrench icon at the bottom
