## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### General Terms

1. The following terms and conditions (“Terms and Conditions”) apply to your participation and membership in the AdvoCat program (“AdvoCat”) of OnlineMedEd (“OME”). It is your responsibility to read and comply with them.
2. The AdvoCat program/offer is available to individuals residing or studying in institutions based in the United States of America. Your membership in AdvoCat constitutes your acceptance of these Terms and Conditions, as well as to any changes or modifications made to them by OME.
3. You must be an active(current) subscriber to any of the premium plans of OME to become a member of AdvoCat.
4. Your membership in AdvoCat is not transferable nor can it be combined with other members.
5. OME reserves the right, in its sole discretion, and with or without notice to you, to add, modify, delete or otherwise change any of these Terms and Conditions, including, without limitation AdvoCat rules, procedures, and benefits, as well as the earning and redemption of AdvoCat points even though such changes may affect your AdvoCat account or the value of AdvoCat points already issued to you. This means that OME may make changes that affect, but are not limited to, rules and procedures for accruing points, of crediting points value, of benefits, blackout rates, and the terms of special offers.
6. OME may terminate AdvoCat at any time, with or without notice to you. As an AdvoCat, you will have three (3) months from the date of termination to complete any credit redemption. However, you will not be entitled to continue to earn qualifying AdvoCat points or credits after the program’s termination date.
7. Fraud, abuse, or any misuse of AdvoCat points or AdvoCat benefits in a manner that is inconsistent with these Terms and Conditions or the intent of AdvoCat program , is subject to appropriate administrative and/or legal action by OME including the forfeiture of your earned AdvoCat points and the revocation of your membership. OME also reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to immediately discontinue your AdvoCat membership, and terminate your account, if you violate any local, state, or federal laws or ordinance or failure to pay any valid bill. Nothing contained in these Terms and Conditions shall limit OME in the exercise of its legal or equitable rights or remedies.
8. As a member of AdvoCat program, you are responsible for promptly advising OME of any

changes to your contact information.

9. Neither OME, nor any affiliate or subsidiary, makes any warranties or representations, either expressed or implied, and expressly disclaims any and all liability (including consequential damages) with respect to type, quality, or fitness of goods or services provided through the AdvoCat, or a third party affiliated with AdvoCat program.
10. As an AdvoCat, you are responsible for remaining knowledgeable regarding these Terms and Conditions. In addition, you are responsible for keeping track of the AdvoCat points in your account. Although OME may advise you of matters of interest regarding AdvoCat, including notification of changes to AdvoCat program, it is not required to do so. Neither OME, its subsidiaries and affiliates, nor companies otherwise participating in AdvoCat program will be liable or responsible for any of the following:
  - a. failure to provide notification of any kind to a member;
  - b. incorrect or inaccurate transcription of member contact information;
  - c. any human error;
  - d. interruption, deletion, omission, defect, or line failure of any telephone network or electronic transmission;
  - e. problems relating to computer equipment, software, inability to access any website or on-line service or any other technical or non-technical error or malfunction;
  - f. requests or correspondence contained in any lost, late, stolen, illegible, incomplete, garbled, misdirected, mutilated or postage due mail or other mail or electronic mail; or
  - g. damages that may be sustained by any member as a result of any of the forgoing.
11. These Terms and Conditions will be interpreted and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas without regard to conflict of law principles. Any dispute with respect thereto or AdvoCat will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the state and federal courts located in Austin, Texas.

## Membership Terms

1. Membership to the AdvoCat program is free for any OME user who is defined as “eligible” by OME
2. OME has the sole discretion to define the rules of eligibility to the AdvoCat program and is subject to change as seen fit by OME, without any notification to its members or users.
3. Once a member of AdvoCat, the individual continues to be a member as long as they participate in the program rules and are considered eligible by OME.

## AdvoCat Points

1. Your AdvoCat membership entitles you to accrue AdvoCat points that are transferred into credits into your OME account.
2. You will earn five (5) AdvoCat points for every new user who signs up and registers at

OnlineMedEd as a student using your own personal referral link. This new user must be truly unique and not be an existing OnlineMedEd user or subscriber. Your user status must be active, registered and associated with the referred user in order to earn points.

3. You will earn fifty (50) AdvoCat points for every new subscriber who signs up for a monthly, six months or any other fixed term plan(except annual plan) with OnlineMedEd. This new subscriber must use your personal referral link to sign up for subscription and must be a new unique subscriber , i.e, they must not have an existing active or inactive account with OnlineMedEd in the past. Your user status must be active and associated with the referred user in order to earn points.
4. You will earn 100 (100) AdvoCat points for every new subscriber who signs up for an annual plan with OnlineMedEd. This new subscriber must use your personal referral link to sign up for subscription and must be a new unique subscriber , i.e, they must not have an existing active or inactive account with OnlineMedEd in the past. Your user status must be active and associated with the referred user in order to earn points.
5. Points will not be allocated retroactively. Any new registered user or subscriber who signs up or pays for a plan prior to using your personal referral link will not accrue you with any corresponding AdvoCat points.
6. Points for a registered referral will accrue soon after the new registration is complete. Points for a new subscription will accrue after the new subscriber has renewed their monthly subscription for the second consecutive month and the refund period has passed.
7. The refund period will be determined by OME on a plan by plan or promotion basis and can be modified at any time at OME discretion.
8. OME reserves the right to adjust AdvoCat points credited to your account if OME determines that an error was made in the calculation thereof.
9. Your AdvoCat points are valid for a period of six months from the date of accrual and will expire if corresponding credits are not redeemed within this period or if you discontinue as a OME subscriber.
10. Once points are expired they are not available for credits and will not be re-allocated.
11. Your AdvoCat points are non-transferable. The sale or barter of any AdvoCat points or benefits is strictly prohibited.
12. OME may offer limited-time promotions that provide bonus points or benefits. These promotions are governed by these Terms and Conditions but may have additional terms and conditions that are specific to the individual promotion . Many of these promotions are only available to you as the AdvoCat member who receives a specific communication from OME. Registration for a special offer for which you are not invited to participate is not permitted. Doing so is a violation of these Terms and Conditions and may result in the cancellation of your AdvoCat membership, forfeiture of all of your AdvoCat points, and restrictions on your ability to rejoin OME and/or AdvoCat program in the future.
13. If you believe you did not receive AdvoCat points for a qualifying referral please contact OME by going to <https://www.onlinemeded/customer-care>. Any request you submit must be accompanied by adequate and unaltered documentation regarding the qualified referral. Failure to supply such documentation may result in the denial of the request for

AdvoCat points. Requests must be received by OME within four (4) weeks from the supposed date of accrual. A late request will not be processed.

## Redeeming AdvoCat Points

1. AdvoCat points are automatically redeemed against USD credits to your OME account. These credits will be applied on your next purchase of OME products, services or scheduled payment for your plan on a first come basis.
2. AdvoCat credits will be allocated at the rate of one(1) USD for every five (5) AdvoCat points with a minimum threshold of 25 points against a five(5) USD credit
3. Any unused points or points that are not sufficient for the minimum threshold will continue to be available for redemption until its last date of validity.
4. To be eligible for crediting points, you, the AdvoCat, must be a paid subscriber at the time of making the credit.
5. The referred friend gift voucher is subject to availability at the participating partner and OME has the discretion to change partners and redemption rules without prior notice to AdvoCat members.
6. The validity of gift voucher is governed by the corresponding partner terms and conditions
7. The recipient of the gift voucher is responsible for all taxes and governmental charges associated with a gift voucher redemption.

## Eligibility of Benefits

1. Periodically on an ad hoc basis you will only be eligible for AdvoCat benefits and special offers to earn and redeem points. These benefits will be updated periodically by OME and will be made available to all or select AdvoCats as per OME discretion and rules of eligibility. Only you as AdvoCat on the account may take advantage of these benefits when they become available.
