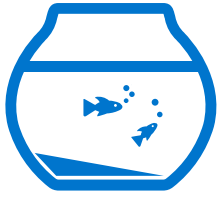


# Year 6 transition



## Fishes and ponds

Typically, Year 6 students leave a small school to join a much bigger secondary school. The new Year 7 is made up of students from a range of feeder schools.

## Top of the class?

Feeder schools take enormous effort to provide secondary schools with accurate assessment data. For a variety of reasons however, secondary schools often resort to their own assessment at the start of Year 7 to rank students. RM Compare can remove this duplication of effort.



## How so?

In this example there are 3 feeder schools. The secondary school sets the same task for their focus - a piece of narrative writing for example. This is completed in an agreed assessment window to make sure everyone starts and ends in reasonable time.

## RM Compare

After uploading the students' work into RM Compare teachers from the 3 schools **AND** the secondary school set about judging the work. Each and every piece of work is judged many times over by the judging pool. Workload for each teacher is reduced significantly however because of the collaborative effort and the RM Compare 'secret sauce'.

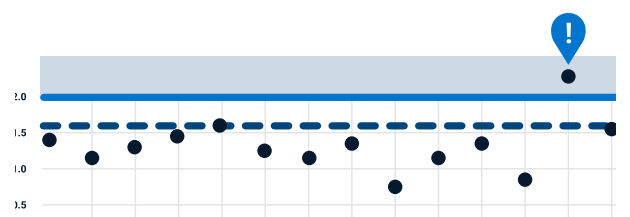


## Results
