

Application Form

- The Audi Home Charging Credit ("the Credit") is intended to assist new Audi electric vehicle owners in Canada who have had their home electrical system upgraded to allow for Level 2 electric vehicle charging. The Credit consists of a rebate up to \$1,500 payable to eligible applicants. The requirements to qualify for the Credit are outlined below.
- To be eligible for the Credit, the applicant must be the current and original owner of an eligible Audi electric vehicle that was <u>purchased or leased, and delivered between January 5th, 2021</u> <u>and January 4th, 2022</u>. Proof of registration is required and must be attached.
- To be eligible for the Credit, "Level 2 electric vehicle charging" is defined as a newly installed, 240V dedicated electrical circuit (and matching receptacle if applicable) capable of supplying at minimum 7.2 kW to the electric vehicle, and installed at or near the electric vehicle's parking location. The electrical installation must be completed <u>between July 1st, 2020 and January</u> <u>31st, 2022</u>.
- To be eligible for the Credit, the applicant's electrical installation must be performed by a qualified, licensed electrical contractor. A licensed electrical contractor is one who has good standing and is officially certified and licensed by the local authority having jurisdiction in the province or territory where the work is performed. For example, in British Columbia, the license must be issued by Technical Safety BC; in Ontario, by the Electrical Safety Authority; in Quebec, by La Corporation des maîtres éléctriciens due Québec; and in New Brunswick, by Electrical Inspection Program Unit (Justice and Public Safety). The installation must be performed in accordance with all applicable electrical safety codes, including any required permits.
- To be eligible for the Credit, a qualified application must be received by the selling Audi dealer no later than March 1st, 2022. To be considered, application forms must be accurately and factually completed. Audi Canada reserves the right to deny, at its sole discretion, any Credit claims arising from incomplete or inaccurate application forms.
- > To be considered complete, the application form must include a copy of the paid invoice clearly indicating:
 - Detailed outline of the work completed
 - Electrical contractor's name, phone number, business address and electrical authority license number
 - Total amount and confirmed payment
