

CHAR-CUTIE-RIE

INGREDIENTS & MATERIALS

- 1 Pouch of Peanut Butter and Banana Creamy Treat from West Paw

- 1/2 Orange bell pepper
- 8 Blueberries
- Large or small Rumbi®

DIRECTIONS

1. Plug the side hole in the Rumbi with a West Paw Beef Heart Freeze-Dried Treat.
