COVID-19 Update

The purpose of this memo is to update you on our community COVID status. We currently have two residents who have tested positive for COVID-19 and are isolating in their condo. They are both experiencing symptoms but are doing well enough to be home. We have several other residents who are isolating due to exposure. They will remain isolated pending receipt of their PCR tests. All of them are doing well, experiencing mild or no symptoms.

Although mild for vaccinated people, this new variant is known to be HIGHY TRANSMISSIBLE. While trending downward, Sarasota County positivity rate is still above 10% while local hospitals are seeing rates around 20%.

Masks continue to be required in common areas. Please continue to be considerate to your neighbors and wear your masks when you leave your home and practice good hand hygiene.

Your cooperation is essential to ensure the safety, health and well-being of everyone in the community. As we discussed yesterday during the town hall meeting, please notify us immediately <u>if you feel symptomatic</u>, so we can perform the necessary testing and prevent the spread of the virus.
