RE: COVID-19 /Coronavirus Update #47H Travel Protocols

Just a reminder, with family members scheduling more family visits, please have them check with Concierge Services in advance of their travel. The state of Florida is experiencing high positivity rates as evidenced by the current positivity rate map.

We request any family member traveling from a county with a 10% or higher positivity rate to please wear a KN95 mask. These are now readily available on Amazon for purchase and speedy delivery. If for some reason, they are unable to obtain a KN95 mask, we will have some at the Concierge Desk.

As a reminder, the ONLY COVID-19 test we accept for entry into our communities is a Polymerase Chain Reaction Test, also known as a PCR test. **Rapid antigen/antibody tests will not be accepted.** Please share this information with your family who are planning to visit from out of state, along with your private employees such as caregivers and housekeepers.
