RE: COVID-19 /Coronavirus Update #40

As we have promised to remain transparent throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, we are informing you we have had three employees test positive for COVID-19 in the last two days.

Two employees work in Independent Living: one in Dining and the other in Concierge Services. After speaking with these two employees we do not feel that any residents nor staff members were exposed to COVID-19. We reviewed the CDC Guidelines for exposure with these employees and were assured that no fellow staff or residents met the exposure threshold. These two employees are home doing well with very minor symptoms and will not return to work until their isolation period has ended and two negative tests, at least 24-hours apart, have been conducted.

The third employee works in Building B of Cadbury Park. This employee was tested with our staff on July 30th and received a negative test result. The positive test was obtained five days later from their second place of employment. This employee is asymptomatic, feels very well and will not return to work until their isolation period has ended and two negative tests, at least 24-hours apart, have been conducted. As a matter of fact, the employee feels so well they re-tested this morning as they believe the test may be a 'false positive'. As a measure of precaution, all residents in Building B have been placed in isolation and will be under clinical review with temperature and oxygen checks occurring twice each shift.

All staff continue to follow best practice infection control procedures and wear masks at all times with all areas being thoroughly cleaned with antibacterial/antiviral disinfectant on a routine basis.

We want to assure you the health and safety of all residents and staff remains our top priority and we will continue to keep you informed. If you have any question or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact us.
