RE:	COVID-19 /Coronavirus Update #46

Holding true to our promise of transparency, throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, this memo is to advise you that a Jacaranda Trace Home Health employee tested positive for the COVID-19 virus. The employee's condition was discovered during our standard two-week testing cycle on October 22nd. The employee is isolating at home, is asymptomatic and doing fine. The employee will remain isolated at home until the isolation period has ended and a negative test result is confirmed. As part of our protocols, subsequent to the employee testing positive, contact tracing was performed on those residents the employee had contact with. One of those residents has tested positive. Like the employee, the resident is asymptomatic and doing fine and is isolating with assistance. The resident is homebound and has not had any contact with any Jacaranda Trace neighbors. The resident will continue to isolate for 14 days and until a negative test result is confirmed. All other employees tested on October 22nd had negative results. In addition, we had a part-time Food & Beverage employee test positive for COVID-19 on October 24, 2020 and based on contact tracing conducted, we have not identified any exposed residents. This employee will also remain isolated at home until a positive test result is confirmed.

All staff continue to follow best practice infection control procedures and wear masks at all times. All appropriate agencies including the Department of Health and Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA) have been notified.

While we do not anticipate any further changing of restrictions, it is important that we continue to <u>strictly adhere</u> to the protocols that we have in place. Continue to wear your masks when outside of your condo, continue to report any sickness or temperatures above 99.6, continue to report your out-of-state travel and out-of-state visitors. With the number of cases rising in Florida, vigilance is the key to maintaining the safety of our communities.

Please be assured that the health and safety of all residents and staff continues to be our priority and we will continue to keep you informed. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact us.
