Bawah Reserve is a boutique resort consisting of six pristine islands, surrounded by spectacular underwater scenery. We have access to 13 dive sites, located either off our shores or just a short boat-ride away. We offer easy, relaxing diving, with vibrant shallow reefs and gentle currents.

As one of Indonesia's first marine conservation areas, Bawah features an abundance of flourishing coral reefs and vibrant marine life. We are proud to be part of the World Wildlife Fund's (WWF) Signing Blue Initiative, and our surrounding lagoons and reefs are marine conservation areas certified by WWF Indonesia.

We are a PADI-certified five-star diving centre with marine biologists on staff. While safety is always our first priority, our mission is to help children and adults fall in love with the ocean and the marine life in it.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Our dive sites have colourful shallow reefs, generally from two to six metres deep, that gently slope down to depths of 25 to 30 metres. We use **Scubapro** diving equipment and offer flexible diving schedules that help you make the most of your underwater experiences.



PAD BUBBLE MAKER

The **PADI Bubblemaker Experience** is a fantastic way to introduce children up to 10 years of age to basic scuba diving skills.

It starts with a safety and theory briefing, where they learn to stay close to their instructors and are shown what to do if they start to feel afraid or get water in their masks.

Once they are comfortable with this, we show them how to assemble their equipment, put it on and then – after practising these skills in our swimming pool – enter the safe shallow reefs of our lagoon for a fun dive to a maximum depth of four metres. If they enjoy the experience and are comfortable we can then take them on additional fun dives from our custom dive boat on the outer reefs, again to a maximum depth of four metres. To ensure the highest standard of safety, each Bawah Reserve diving instructor teaches no more than two students at a time.

Once you're competent, confident and ready to experience the magic of diving, you will accompany your instructor to one of the beautiful reefs around Bawah Reserve for a fun dive to a depth of no more than 12 metres.

Our **Scuba Refresher** is designed to quickly reintroduce you to diving and boost your confidence by reinforcing your existing skills and dive knowledge.

Required for certified divers who haven't been diving in one year or more, this short course includes a dive theory review as well as a practical guided session to refresh your dive techniques. After a discussion about your previous dive experiences we design the refresher around you; by tailoring the skills to include aspects of diving that you may have struggled with in the past, so you are completely confident when experiencing our vibrant reefs. We review your skills and answer your questions before practising the skills and having a mini dive in the sheltered waters of Bawah Reserve's lagoon.

Suitable for beginners and seasoned divers alike, Fun Diving is the ideal way to experience the incredible underwater world surrounding Bawah Reserve. After a short 15-minute boat ride, you will enjoy exclusive access to pristine reefs and marine landscapes harbouring high levels of marine biodiversity.

PADI NIGHT DIVING

Experience the thrill of **Night Diving** here at the Reserve. Night diving provides an alternative, exciting look into the underwater world. Night dives offer a totally different perspective on any dive site you may have experienced during the day.

By showcasing underwater life that is well hidden while the sun is in the sky, night diving offers wonderful insights into the reef after dark. You will commonly see coral feeding, plus crabs, shrimp, moray eels, nudibranchs and other invertebrates roaming their territory; even the glow of bioluminescent plankton. The incomparable mystery and calm of a night dive offers an unforgettable experience for any diver. Night diving is available to anyone with a PADI (or equivalent) Advanced Open Water certification. If you only have an Open Water certification you may join a Night Dive as part of a PADI Adventure Dive, or your PADI Advanced Open Water Course.

Marine Conservation is recognised as vital to the continued health of our planet and is something that we at Bawah Reserve are very passionate about.

With this programme we ensure you receive an understanding of the threats that underwater ecosystems face and practical experience in our marine conservation efforts. All marine conservation dives are preceded by a 45 minute presentation from one of our qualified Marine Biologists.

CORAL TRANSPLANTING

Make your dive count! Although the majority of coral reefs surrounding Bawah Reserve are flourishing, a few areas have been affected by decades of unsustainable fishing. Our marine biologists have identified the reefs most in need of repair, and our dive guests are now invited to actively participate in repopulating them with healthy coral from our coral nursery.

UNDERWATER CLEAN UP

Join our dive team and assist with our marine conservation efforts. This dive will include searching for and removing man made debris that has floated onto our reefs on water currents, such as drift nets that get tangled in our reef, or plastic items.

REEF HEALTH MONITORING

This educational dive programme is designed to enhance your knowledge of coral reefs while you learn how to help them remain healthy for future generations. You will learn survey techniques and then participate in a survey at one of our 7 sites and help monitor the health of our reefs.



Marine Conservation Adoption

The underwater world is a marvel of fascinating ecosystems teeming with a rich variety of vibrantly coloured marine plants and sea creatures. At Bawah Reserve, we believe wholeheartedly in marine conservation and are doing all we can to protect the Anambas reefs.

For valued guests who share our commitment to marine conservation, we offer adoption programmes that give you the opportunity to directly influence and support this work of ours.

ADOPT A TURTLE NEST USD \$200 (season-dependent)

To protect our local population of turtle nests we patrol and relocate freshly laid eggs in our purpose-built nest enclosure where we can protect them from poachers and other predators.

By adopting one of our turtle nests, you will be supporting our efforts to increase the local population of these endangered creatures. We will send you information on the number and species of successful hatchlings, plus photos of the miraculous event.

ADOPT A CORAL TREE NURSERY USD \$300 p/year

Coral trees are safe spaces where threatened coral fragments from our local reefs receive the nutrients they need to grow and thrive. After maturing they are transplanted on to a natural or artificial reef structure by our marine conservation divers (that could be you!), where they continue to grow.

ADOPT A CORAL SPIDER OR BOTTLE REEF USD \$350 p/year or \$1,500 for a whole site

Coral spiders are stainless steel frames that help rebuild reefs where they have been damaged. We attach coral fragments to the metal structure, and fish are able to swim through the gaps. As the coral grows, it starts to spread out and will eventually envelop the metal.

Bottle reefs are a sustainable answer to rebuilding reef environments. They're made from recycled wine bottles on a concrete base, materials that will take thousands of years to decompose, giving the coral a chance to grow and cover the surrounding area.

ADOPT A HEXADOME USD \$750 p/year or \$2,500 for a whole site

Hexadomes are artificial reef structures to rehabilitate damaged reefs. By forming a three-dimensional landscape on previously bare reef, they rapidly become sanctuaries for large numbers of fish and other sea creatures. These domes will last for many years – long enough for the natural reef to fully reestablish itself.



TURTLE SATELLITE TAGGING USD \$4,000

Our marine conservation team has the ambitious goal of being the first group in the Riau islands to utilise GPS technology to tag and track the movements of endangered hawksbill and green turtles.

This tagging programme would allow our team of marine biologists to track the turtles so as to monitor their movements. This information could lead to the identification of key foraging sites for Bawah's population of breeding sea turtles, leading to the creation of expansion of Marine Protected Areas to help with the continued conservation of these sea turtles.

As an adopter, you would be able to name your turtle, have access to the Argos Satellite System so as to track your turtle's movements, and be updated on the impact of the research. Just imagine the satisfaction of supporting such a worthwhile project!

If you want to dive, this is where it starts! The **PADI Open Water** certification course is the first step towards discovering the spectacular marine ecosystem beneath the waves. This performance-based course will provide you with the skills to dive – not only around Bawah Reserve, but at diving spots all over the world.

You will learn the major aspects of diving theory, diving equipment and diving skills. To save precious time, this part of the course can be completed before you come to Bawah.

Skills Practice & Open Water In-Water Training Dives

Having studied the theory behind safe diving, you will join a Bawah Reserve Dive Instructor in shallow water to learn the skills needed for open water dives. Dives Now we move to deeper water over 4 dives, culminating in an open

culminating in an open water dive to a maximum of 18 metres, where you will demonstrate your mastery of skills learned in the shallow water and utilise the confidence you have developed through the course to relax and enjoy the underwater scenery.

The **PADI Advanced Open Water Diver** course increases your competence and

confidence by expanding your dive theory knowledge and building your skills.

PART 1

Theory (e-Learning)

You will learn about adventure dives, including the practical aspects and physiological effects of deeper scuba diving and how to navigate using water compasses, kick cycles, visual landmarks and time. You will also learn how to use your dive computer more effectively.

To save time, this part of the course can be completed before arriving at Bawah.

PART 2

Open Water Adventure Dives

This performance based course includes five adventure dives, of which two must be adventure dives that focus on deep scuba diving and navigation skills. For the other three dives, you can choose from:

PEAK PERFORMANCE BUOYANCY

Perfect buoyancy is the hallmark of a skilled diver. Learn to glide effortlessly, and to ascend and descend as if by thought. Practisce your buoyancy over this two-dive course and take your skills to the next level.

NIGHT DIVER

Experience the joy of diving during the hours of darkness. Learn techniques to keep you feeling comfortable and safe underwater at night, and then marvel at all the wondrous creatures that hide themselves from sight during the day. From crabs to bioluminescent plankton, night diving offers incredible experiences. If you're especially lucky, you may even see coral spawning, which has been described as a once-in-a-lifetime experience!

DIGITAL UNDERWATER

If your underwater photos tend to be blue and blurry, this is the course for you! Learning different techniques will allow you to find the right subject, positioning and composition for your photos and allow you to record great images of the underwater world.

- ~ Primary assessment
- ~ Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
- ~ Serious bleeding, shock and spinal injury management
- ~ Conscious and unconscious choking management
- ~ Injury and illness assessment
- ~ Bandaging and splinting for dislocations and fractures
