What is the Full 90 Club?

Our Full 90 Club membership makes you a part of the Spirit Family. This season ticket program is your way to connect with other fans, receive exclusive merchandise, and experience events made for our community.

When does the seat selection process begin?

Monday, May 10th. Keep your email notifications on for the link to access!

How much does a Full 90 Club Membership cost?

\$125-\$840 based on your seating preference and venue.

How many matches are being played at Audi Field this season?

We will have 12 regular season home matches between Audi Field and Segra Field. Seven (7) matches will be played at Audi Field, and five (5) at Segra Field.

Will the seat deposit act as a credit towards my overall Full 90 Club membership cost?

Yes, your deposit purchase will be credited to your account and applied towards your 2021 Full 90 Club membership.

What about my ticket purchase from 2020?

Your purchase has been credited to your Spirit account to be applied towards your 2021 ticket purchase.

Is there a way to donate unused tickets?

You will be able to donate your unused tickets

to local nonprofits. Please contact your account representative for arrangements.

What if I want to sit with the Spirit Squadron or Rose Room Collective supporter groups?

Supporters stand in Section 137 at Audi Field and Section 117 at Segra Field.

What if I require ADA seating?

ADA options will be available. Please note this information to your ticket representative for accommodations.
