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Conduct regular risk assessments

Risk assessments shouldn't be a static thing. They need to be updated regularly and should include the protective measures that you're going to put in place.



Limit group sizes

The government guidance also suggests that in instances where you're unable to maintain bubbles, you should aim to keep your students in a small group of no more than 15 children.



Stay outdoors where possible

This will reduce the number of things that need to be cleaned. And research suggests that transmission rates are lower outdoors than indoors.



Clean equipment regularly

Ensure that where equipment is used, there is a plan for cleaning after each use before putting it back into storage.
