Traveling in the backcountry requires a solid understanding of avalanche risk and the knowledge to mitigate these risks through appropriate terrain assessment and decision making. Our friendly AIARE certified leaders and instructors will teach you how to recognize, manage, and minimize these hazards and reduce risks while having a great time. Our AIARE Level 1 Avalanche Course is a 3-day course that combines both classroom and field instruction to introduce participants to the hazards of traveling in avalanche terrain.
