

What is a supplier diversity program?

A supplier diversity program is a strategy that ensures a diverse supplier base in the procurement of goods and services for any business or organization. Over 90% of S&P 100 companies spend an average of \$3 billion annually on certified diverse suppliers. Businesses that can get certified as being diverse are at least 51% owned and operated by U.S. Citizens who are any of the following:

• Women

- Members of the LGBTQIA+ community
- Members of ethnic minority groups
- Veterans or service disabled veterans

Why is supplier diversity important?

Supplier diversity programs exist so that companies can hit their corporate social responsibility and diversity, equity, and inclusion goals, but also so that private firms can win government contracts, many of which contain stipulations about diverse supply chains.

How do businesses get certified?

Eligible businesses can be certified through one of the following agencies or any of their subsidiaries:
