

5 Ways to Use Vector LiveSafe During Inclement Winter Weather

1

Broadcast Messages

Send broadcast messages to your community to keep them informed.

Use Case: Send a broadcast message via text, email, or the Vector LiveSafe Mobile App to notify users of weather-related road closures.

2

Report Incidents & Suspicious Activity

Inclement weather can lead to injury, facility issues, and other safety and security concerns.

Use Case: Users can report safety hazards (ex: black ice) or facilities concerns (ex: frozen pipes) using Tip Submit.

3

Broadcast Check In

Have members of your community check in on the app so you know that they are safe during hazardous winter weather.

Use Case: During dangerous storms, send check-ins to users to ensure community safety.

4

Geofence

Create geofences around specific locations to ensure you are reaching the people who at the highest risk for inclement weather.

Use Case: During holiday breaks, send messages to users who are still on campus.

5

Resources

Upload institutionspecific inclement weather policies, guidance, and more to the Mobile App's "Resources" section.

Use Case: During a storm, users can reference weather-related safety protocols.
