Broadcast Messages

Send broadcast messages to your community to keep them informed of the inclement weather.
Remember you can send messages via text, email, and push notification via the LiveSafe Mobile App.

Tip Submit

Encourage your students, faculty, and staff to report safety questions or concerns; hurricanes and tropical storms can lead to facility hazards, theft, suspicious activity, property damage, and more.

3

Check-In

Send Broadcast Check-In messages to members of your community so they can report whether they are safe or in need of assistance before, during, or after a hurricane or tropical storm. 4

Geofence

Create custom geofences to ensure you are reaching the community members who face the highest risk from inclement weather (ex: those who live on a particularly-affected area of campus).

5

Custom Card

Add a custom hurricane and tropical storm card to your LiveSafe home screen. It can include storm information, evacuation plans, response guidance, points of contact, and other relevant information.
