## Broadcast Alerts

Send broadcast messages to your community to inform them of health and safety threats and relevant procedures.

**Use Case:** Send alerts about safety hazards such as inclement weather via email, text, or push notification.

Students and faculty can submit reports regarding health or safety concerns and tips will be routed to relevant personnel.

**Use Case:** If a student is experiencing mental health disruptions, they or a friend or classmate can request help.

## Check In

Send a check in message to your community so that they can mark whether they are safe during emergencies.

**Use Case:** Students and faculty can reply to a broadcast check in as "OK" or "Need Help" during an emergency.
