

Additional Covid-19 Measures in Secondary

We will maintain the following measures in line with recommendations from the authorities to help safeguard the health of the whole school community, and inform you of any changes as and when occur.

- Students are reminded to frequently wash/sanitize their hands throughout the school day, refrain from sharing food or drinks, avoid physical contact with others and maintain physical distancing as much as possible. We count on your support to discuss the importance of these measures with your children.
- Students should arrive at school between 8:00 and 8:10 and leave the site promptly at the end of their last lesson/club of the day.
- Lessons are in full size classes and the after-school club programme runs in line with the most up-to-date recommendations from the authorities.
- All secondary students and all teachers and adults **MUST** wear a mask in ALL lessons, corridors and common areas. All must keep their distances when eating at lunchtime.
- **Secondary students MUST bring their own masks to school each day.**
- **Students over the age of 12 should wear their own masks when using the school minibuses.**
- Mobile phones **MUST** be handed in during registration at the start of the day and will be returned in registration at the end of the day.
- Individual student lockers will be allocated and used.
- Specific areas will be designated for different year groups at break time to keep them separate as much as possible.
- **Students should arrive at school in their sports kit on days when they have sport as changing rooms will not be open until further notice. School uniform should be worn on other days.**
- Students should move around the school on the right hand side of stairs and hallways, whilst maintaining sufficient distance between each other. They should not socialise in clusters. The stairs in the new building are DOWN only.
