

Release Notes – XMReality Remote Guidance Q2 2021

New and Updated Features

Web Guide Station

The Q2 release of the web-based guide station application contains a number of improvements and additional features:

- Contacts are now available in the web-based guide station. You can initiate a new call to a contact as well as inviting contacts to ongoing calls.
- There is a new call log view showing the call history.
- Video recording is now supported.
- Image capture is now supported
- Federated log-in is now supported.

The web guide station is available in the Enterprise tier only and can be found at guidestation.xmreality.com. No additional licensing is needed, you log in with your usual XMReality log-in credentials.

Local Language Support

The applications (Windows, Android, iOS and web client) do now support a number of local languages. If your device is configured to use any of the supported languages the XM app will use that language as well. If your local language is not supported English will be used instead. The following languages are supported in the Q2 release:

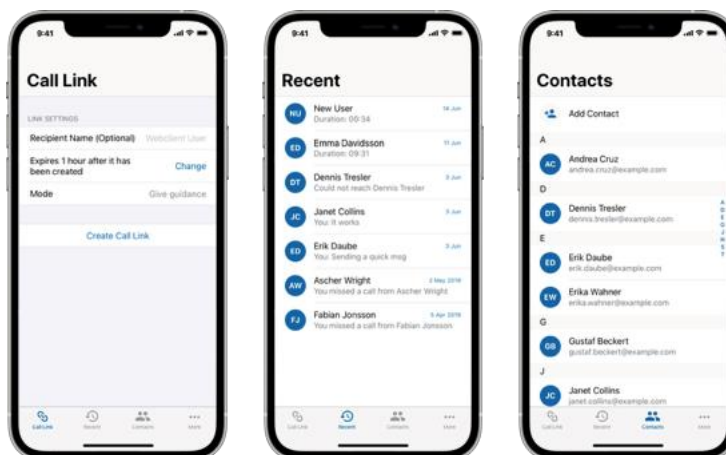
The Administration Portal and the Web-based Guide Station are available in English only.

Show Recorded Video

Using the Q2 release you can now share previously recorded videos from your mobile as an alternative to the live camera feed. All standard guidance features are available also when sharing recorded video. This feature is available on the Android and iOS apps. Windows and web-based guide station clients can share recorded videos by using the share window feature together with your regular video player.

New Tab-based UI

An updated tab-based UI is introduced for the Enterprise version of the apps (Android and iOS). The new UI makes it easier to generate and send out call links and provides a more modern look.



Known Limitations

Compatibility with old app versions

Using the new Q2-2021 features requires that you update your clients to the new versions as per the table below.

Web Guide Station

The Web Guide Station is designed targeting W3C standards for browsers. We aim to have the application work on major browsers on the common operating systems, but support is currently limited to Chrome, Microsoft Edge and Safari on desktop operating systems. Other platforms might still work but with limitations in functionality.

In addition, the following limitations are also known in this release of the Web Guide Station:

- Exposure control for hands-overlay not working properly on OSX (Safari and Chrome).
