Digital Payment Glossary

Terms related to digital payments and mobile transactions that you should know.





Digital payments

The transfer of funds from one digital device to another, including point of sales devices, computers, phones, and centralized platforms.



Mobile payments

Using mobile phone to pay for physical products or digital services with a credit card or mobile wallet.



Digital wallet

An online service, software, or app that lets users make electronic transactions without entering credit card information each time.



Scan-to-pay

A form of digital payment in which a user scans a QR code and makes a payment to a merchant without having to enter merchant account details.



Tap to pay

Secure payments that use short-range wireless technology to communicate between a contactless chip card or mobile device and a contactless-enabled checkout terminal.



Chip cards (EMV Cards)

A type of credit/debit card embedded with a computer chip that makes payments more secure.



eCommerce

The use of the internet for commercial purposes including banking and the purchase of goods and services.



PCI-DSS (Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard)

The standard for payment processors to protect credit card data when they process MasterCard, Visa and other card transactions
