Annual Fund Support Makes These Blessings Possible







Donors responded to an appeal for undesignated gifts to meet COVID-19 requirements and other uncertainties during the 2020-2021 school year.

More than 85 percent of gifts were undesignated making it possible for administrators to install protective shields and air purifiers and provide online learning.



Undesignated gifts also made unexpected roadway repairs possible when subsurface sinking caused asphalt to buckle on the northwest corner of campus.
