## PROCEEDINGS OF THE COMMISSION

Special meeting of the Commission held October 17, 2011.

Commission President Alesch called the meeting to order at 11:00 a.m.

#### 1) Solids Management Plan workshop.

B. Bartel reported the Green Bay Metropolitan Sewerage District must replace its solids handling facility due to aging infrastructure, environmental compliance with the Maximum Achievable Control Technology (MACT) standards by May 2016, and a need for increased evaporative capacity of the incinerators. He reviewed the following:

- MACT standards
- Rehabilitation of multiple hearth furnaces
- Co-digestion analysis
- Alternative refinement

E. Rothstein from Galardi Rothstein Group reviewed the impact and rate analysis of Alternatives 2, 3A, and 3B.

B. Bartel reported that staff plans to request Commission approval of Alternative 3B for the Solids Management Plan at the October 26 meeting.

Commissioner Meinz asked when the design engineer would be selected. T. Sigmund replied after the Department of Natural Resources approves the Facility Plan.

The Commission requested the following information:

- Alternatives for financing of the Solids Management Plan
- Payback to increase the digester size for co-digestion
- Digestion of algae
- Solids Management Plan schedule
- Difference in operation & maintenance (O&M) costs for new solids facility minus present solids O&M costs
- Proforma of expenses and income for the next 10 years
